Candidates who do not have at least the position of Lecturer (obtained through a competition for title) or candidates who do not come from the higher education system, will sustain, additional, a lecture (course) whose theme will be determined by the Competition Board in the appropriate post topic.</p>

The Europass CV of the candidate must include: - information on the studies undertaken and degrees obtained; - information on the professional experience and relevant jobs previously held; - information on the R&amp;D projects he/she has led as project leader and grants obtained, if any, indicating for each source of funding, the volume of funding and the main publications or patents resulting; - information on awards or other recognition of the candidate's scientific contributions;</p> <p>4. A list of the candidate's work, in printed and electronic format. The complete list of the candidate's works will be structured as follows: - list of a maximum of 10 works considered by the candidate to be the most relevant to the field of the disciplines of the post for which he/she is applying; - doctoral thesis or theses; - patents and other industrial property titles; - books and chapters in books; - articles/studies in extenso, published in journals of the main international scientific stream; - publications in extenso, published in proceedings of the main international specialist conferences; - other scientific works and contributions or, where appropriate, in the field of artistic creation;</p> <p>5. The university's standard examination form for the competition, in printed and electronic format, the standard format of which is laid down in its own methodology. The verification sheet is completed and signed by the candidate;</p> <p>6. Documents relating to the possession of a doctoral degree/proof of enrolment in a doctoral study programme, without exceeding the maximum period of study, including extensions admissible by law: a certified copy of the doctoral degree and, if the original doctoral degree is not recognised in Romania, the certificate of recognition or equivalence of this degree;</p> <p>7. The summary, in Romanian and in an international language, of the doctoral thesis, on a maximum of one page for each language;</p> <p>8. A sworn statement by the candidate indicating the situations of incompatibility provided for by the Law on Higher Education no. 199/2023, as subsequently amended and supplemented, in which he/she would find him/herself in the event of winning the competition or the absence of such situations of incompatibility;</p> <p>9. Candidates for positions of university professor or scientific researcher grade I, have to include in the competition file at least 3 names and contact addresses of personalities from the respective field from abroad who have accepted to elaborate letters of recommendation regarding the professional qualities of the candidate.
