BUCHAREST

Bucharest, the capital of Romania, is a vibrant city that blends history, culture, and modern development. Known as "Little Paris" for its elegant architecture, it is the country's political and economic hub. The city is home to iconic landmarks like the massive Palace of the Parliament, the Romanian Athenaeum, and the Arcul de Triumf. Bucharest boasts a rich cultural scene with museums, theaters, and a lively nightlife, particularly in the Old Town. While the city has faced challenges, it has undergone significant modernization, improving infrastructure and preserving historical sites. Today, Bucharest continues to thrive as a dynamic metropolis that balances tradition and progress.



FROM OTOPENI HENRI COANDA AIRPORT

Transport:

- The Bucharest Metro and an extensive network of buses, trams, and trolleys make getting around easy.
 - Henri Coanda International Airport connects the city to destinations worldwide
- ✔ If you want to take the **BUS Line 100** from the Airport Otopeni Henri Coanda to the city, you can buy the ticket from the bus by card, the price is 3 lei (ron). Bus 100 runs to downtown Bucharest via Arcul de Triumf and Piața Victoriei to Piața Unirii, every 30 min, 24 hours a day.
- ✔ The **TRAIN** provides a fast connection between Henri Coandă Airport and Bucharest North Railway Station. Trains run 24 hours a day, every 40 minutes. The duration of the trip is approx. 20 minutes, and the ticket is 6 lei (ron)
- ✔ **TAXI - Apps:** Many locals and visitors use taxi apps like Clever Taxi, Star Taxi, or ride-sharing apps like Bolt and Uber. Most drivers speak basic English, but it's helpful to have your destination written down or shown on a map.
